HOLY THURSDAY, April 5

Entering the Three Days...the beginning of Good Friday:

MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER, 7:00 p.m.

The Word of the Lord; The Washing of Feet; The Holy Eucharist;
Procession of the Blessed Sacrament; Quiet Prayer in the Chapel

HOLY THURSDAY NIGHT PRAYER, 10:00 p.m.

This prayer at the end of the day continues the holiness of these days,
marked by vigilance and faithful prayer

GOOD FRIDAY, April 6

A day of fast (only one full meal) and abstinence from meat.

SOLEMN LITURGY

OF THE PASSION & DEATH OF THE LORD 12:10 p.m.

The Word of the Lord; Prayers for the World;
Veneration of the Holy Cross; Holy Communion.

The 12:10 Service is the main Liturgy of Good Friday.

In keeping with the Church's tradition the Liturgy of the
Lord's Death is celebrated in the afternoon of Good Friday.
Good Friday should be a day of quiet and prayer. Consider
taking Good Friday off from work.
