Lighting UPDATE...

Let there be LIGHT! You may have noticed...there is LIGHT in our worship space. The “inner workings” of all the “house lights” in the worship space have been replaced. The light is brighter and more evenly dispersed throughout the assembly area. All of the new spot lights have been installed and “on-line.”

As of August 13 they have been focused on various areas of the worship space (altar, ambo, cross, weavings, icons, font, art, choir area, etc.).

The spots are all interchangeable and can be refocused on different areas for different liturgical celebrations or events. “Color temperature” of the spotlights has also been adjusted. The former spotlights have been removed.

The programming and dimming system is completely installed. All the lighting will be dimmable and programmable (which means different settings for various liturgical needs can be “programmed” and controlled.) The various spotlights can be rearranged and used to focus on various areas of the worship space.

Due to the continuing generosity of Blessed Trinity parishioners through our Capital Campaign, this portion of our “project” is completely paid for.
