**UPDATE...**

**July 25/August 1, 2021**

**LAND SALE PROGRSS.** Work continues on the potential sale of our excess land. Potential purchaser and developer continues to work with the city of Missoula regarding various issues, such as access, Eaton street development, water and sewer concerns, etc.,

**CONSULTATION/COLLABORATION** with Ken Griesemer, our liturgical design consultant, continues. He is working directly with our Architect Carl Posowitz (of Paradigm Architects). The **STRATEGIC PLANNING TEAM** requested that Ken begin preliminary design possibilities for the new baptismal font, altar, ambo, cross and the image of Mary. Recall that at the last **FULL PARISH MEETING**, it was determined that we should proceed with worship space renovation as finances allowed. When and if the excess land is sold, the entire project (which includes the gathering space addition, Blessed Sacrament Chapel relocation, bathroom and office renovations, social hall and office lighting updates, parish kitchen updates, landscaping and parking reconfiguration) will proceed immediately.

**AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED:** New worship space **LIGHTING** is completely installed (some adjustments continue to be made). The new **SOUND SYSTEM** in both worship space and social center is completely installed. Hearing assistance devices are available. Planning and design for the installation of the new **ORGAN** into its permanent place in the upper portion of the worship space, above the ambo, continues.

## **CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PROGRESS**

As of July 18, 2021 we have reached **71%** of our **\$500,000** goal.

**57%** of parishioners have participated thus far.

As of June 6 we have received **\$223,179** in cash:
