Excavation has begun outside, West of the main entrance, for the small addition to our building for the permanent installation of the organ.

This will include a small outside addition to the building, providing the needed space for the organ pipes to the west of the window. The construction has been carefully planned by our architects, Paradigm Architectural firm and the company from which we secured the organ, Rollie Rutz. When the construction is completed, the next phase will be the actual installation of the organ which will be done by Mr. Rutz and his team.

## **Blessed Trinity Capital Campaign Progress**
