

## October 15, 2023 Blessed Trinity Capital Campaign Progress

Our three year Capital Campaign concluded on March 31, 2023

As of October 8, 2023 we have received \$370,387—96% of the \$386,118 committed (our goal was \$500,000).

(22 Households have exceeded their committed contributions)

## Completion of ORGAN INSTALLATION.

Final work on the installation the BLESSED TRINITY ORGAN is scheduled to begin October 23 and should be completed by October 29. This will include completion of the woodwork framing; installation of front grill and the "bell/chimes" portion of the organ, as well as a full tuning.

Rollie Rutz and Ben Klemer of Rutz Organ Co., Morristown MN, are the installers.

Construction of the addition for the organ was accomplished by Jeremiah Wendell of SUMMIT BUILDERS GROUP.
