# November 19, 2023 Blessed Trinity Renovation Project UPDATE...

## LAND SALE PROGRESS

On November 9, 2023 Bishop Vetter, on behalf of Fr. Ed and Blessed Trinity, signed the BUY-SELL AGREEMENT with Roland, LLC, for the sale of the western portion of our property. This includes a portion of the West side parking lot. Access to this development project will be from Eaton street on the Southern side of church property. This “access easement” agreement will be executed soon. The “Buy-Sell Agreement” has been thoroughly reviewed and vetted by our Diocesan attorneys. The buyer will soon begin the process with the City of Missoula for the required “Boundary Change” between the “sold portion” of our land and our remaining property. The final sale of the property is contingent upon the City’s boundary change approval and execution. We are beginning the process of meeting with our architects (PARADIGM 3 ARCHITECTURE) to begin developing the final architectural construction documents. Our contractor is Jeremiah Wendell, SUMMIT BUILDERS GROUP

**AFTER CHRISTMAS** there will be a **FULL PARISH GATHERING** to review project plans, expectations and our **WAY FORWARD**.

## Blessed Trinity Capital Campaign **PROGRESS...**

Our three year Capital Campaign concluded on March 31, 2023  
As of November 12, 2023 we have received **\$374,400—97%**  
of the **\$386,543** committed (*our goal was \$500,000*).  
(22 Households have exceeded their committed contributions)
