HOLY THURSDAY, March 28

Entering the Three Days...the beginning of Good Friday:

MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER, 7:00 pm

Receiving the Holy Oils; The Word of the Lord; The Washing of Feet; Collection for those in need; The Holy Eucharist; Procession of the Blessed Sacrament; Quiet Prayer in the Chapel.

HOLY THURSDAY NIGHT PRAYER, 10:00 pm

This prayer at the end of the day continues the holiness of these days, marked by vigilance and faithful prayer.

The Paschal Fast begins following the Holy Thursday Mass and concludes following the Easter Vigil. This is a time of fasting from food (one full meal a day) and from meat on Good Friday.

We fast in order to focus our lives on the mystery into which we enter.

GOOD FRIDAY, March 29

A day of fast (only one full meal) and abstinence from meat.

LITURGY OF THE PASSION & DEATH OF THE LORD, 12:10 pm

The Word of the Lord; Prayers for the World; Veneration of the Holy Cross; Holy Communion.

The 12:10 Service is the main Liturgy of Good Friday.

In keeping with the Church's tradition the Liturgy of the Lord's Death is celebrated in the afternoon of Good Friday. Good Friday should be a day of quiet and prayer.

Consider taking Good Friday off from work.





Holy Saturday Morning, March 30 MORNING PRAYER OF THE LORD'S REST IN THE TOMB, 11:00 am THE PASCHAL FAST CONTINUES THROUGHOUT THIS DAY.

For all this should be a day of rest and quiet; a day to remember; a day to pray for peace in quiet solitude.
