The font is a symbol of both tomb and womb; its power is the power of the triumphant cross; and Baptism sets the Christian on the path to the life that will never end, the ‘eighth day’ of eternity where Christ’s reign of peace and justice is celebrated.”

“The font should be large enough to supply ample water for the baptism of both adults and infants. Since baptism in Catholic churches may take place by immersion in the water, or by pouring, fonts that permit all forms of baptismal practice are encouraged.”



The FONT...
Part of the current construction project, but finishing will be funded through this new campaign. The font will be eight sided,

representing the traditional “eighth day of creation,” the new age of Christ. The interior and top will be black granite, with an “infinity edge.” The water will flow silently and will be visible from all areas of the worship space. Carved into the black granite at the bottom of the font will be the ancient Celtic symbol of the Blessed Trinity.
